### Updates to MO Scholars Program

The 2024 Legislative Session resulted in a number of positive changes to the MO Scholars program for families. While students still must qualify, based on a) IEP/ISP status or income, and b) public school attendance or K-1 status, beginning as soon as August 28, 2004, geographic restrictions will cease. Eligible students may apply from anywhere in Missouri. Another significant change is that incomebased eligibility has expanded to include those making 300% of the federal poverty level. Previously, for example, total family income for a family of 4 was capped at \$62,400. Under the 2024 legislation, the cap for a family of 4 has been raised to \$93,600.

Individuals and businesses who pay at least \$1,000.00 in taxes to the State of Missouri are able to direct up to 50% of their tax burden to the MO Scholars program, which will issue those dollars to schools like Outreach Christian Education. Last year, 17 OCE students were able to attend OCE as a direct result of the MO Scholars Program! However, we know of at least 30 more students who want to attend OCE and are eligible for the program, but for whom funds have not been secured.

The program needs more taxpayers who are willing to redirect their tax burden to the fund.

The newly formed Donor Development Committee is eager to share this opportunity with individuals and businesses in the community who support educational choice.
